

faux fur throw

materials

1.5m of 150cm wide faux fur

1.5m of 150cm wide satin backed crepe or any 150cm wide fabric

pins

sewing machine

matching thread



1

With right sides together pin the two fabric squares together all the way around.

2

Stitch the two pieces together leaving a 50cm opening in the centre of one side.

3

Turn right side out and hand stitch the opening closed.

ideas to THROW around

There's so many ways to change the look of a throw rug. Try different fabrics as the backing. This can create colour and pattern contrasts and means the throw can suit more than one room. Your fabric choices define the formality or informality of the throw but also how it feels. For true snuggle power you can't go past polar fleece! Some fabrics - like cotton and suede - are reversible; different looks and textures are seen and felt depending on which side you choose to display. For a groovy look try blanket stitching the edges using DMC thread and if you want some added glamour, add a tassel or two.
